INFORMATION PAPER F-RATE PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

E-Rate is a Universal Service Fund Federal program administered by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) under the direction of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to provide funds for Schools and Libraries. E-Rate will fund up to 80% of eligible costs for both Category 1 (Data Transmission Services and/or Internet Access) and Category 2 (access points, routers, switches, hubs, and wiring) services.

FACTS

- PPLD already uses E-Rate Category 1 services through June 2020 (pays for costs associated with PPLD wide area network and internet services)
- Government funding for Category 2 services expire September 30, 2019, potential for Congressional reauthorization in 2020, but not guaranteed
- Information Technology (IT) Department FY19 Capital Budget set aside funds for Data Center Redesign totaling \$188K for replacing one Date Center in FY20 and the other in FY21 estimated costs is \$250K per Data Center
- Switch replacement project totaling \$185K for FY19 execution
- Data Center redesign will include E-Rate eligible routers, switches, hubs, and wiring, but excludes Data Center servers
 (estimated cost \$110K for servers)
- Leveraging E-Rate Category 2 funding provides opportunity to defray "some" of the estimated \$500K Data Center redesign and switch costs
- Potential for FY19 implementation for one or both Data Centers
- E-Rate program requires adherence to ridged timelines and compliance with BOT Financial Guidelines to obtain funds
- PPLD must complete E-Rate process no later than March 27, 2019
- Process is completed once USAC is notified of Board of Trustees approved vendor for the following E-Rate related RFPs;
 - Decision 19-3-6: Virtual Networking System for Datacenters (RFP #520-29-02)
 - Decision 19-3-7: Core Switch Acquisition (RFP # 520-19-03)
- Potential cost savings is \$312K (80% of E-Rate eligible \$389K) for Data Center
- Potential cost savings for switch acquisition estimated at \$40K
- Actual savings will also depend on vendor response to RFP and Category 2 eligible equipment and services included in the technical solution
